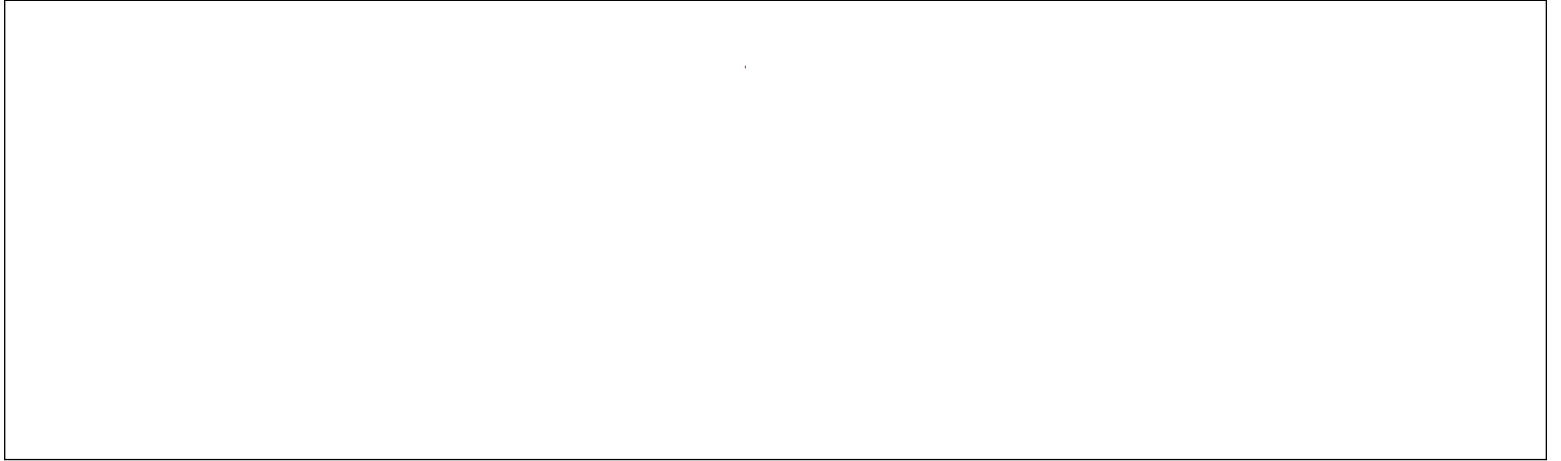
2015 Tax Returns

You must submit signed copies of your and your parents' 2015 federal tax returns. U.S. citizens and permanent residents should send their tax returns (including all W2 forms and schedules) to the College Board's Imaging and Documentation Service (IDOC) and not to Yale Student Financial Services. These forms are required even if you have given permission to the IRS to populate the FAFSA, or have chosen to submit a tax transcript.
